? Who are the Spring & Autumn Schools suitable for?

Our programmes are primarily aimed at international (exchange) students who will be studying at TU Braunschweig in the following semester. In addition, we are happy to welcome international students, prospective students, and young professionals who are interested in German language and culture.

? Do I need prior knowledge of German to participate?

No prior knowledge of German is required to participate in our programmes, as we offer instruction starting from the beginner level. Participants with existing language skills will be placed in groups that correspond to their proficiency level.

? Are there any requirements to participate?

You must be at least 18 years old, and all participants are required to have international health and liability insurance.

? Where do TU Braunschweig Spring & Autumn Schools take place?

The classes take place on campus of TU Braunschweig. In addition, our programmes include many excursions within Braunschweig as well as day trips to other German cities.

? Are there any scholarship opportunities?

Yes, we regularly offer scholarships for our Spring & Autumn Schools. Please visit our website to check your eligibility for available scholarships.

? Will I receive a certificate? Can I transfer credits to my degree programme?

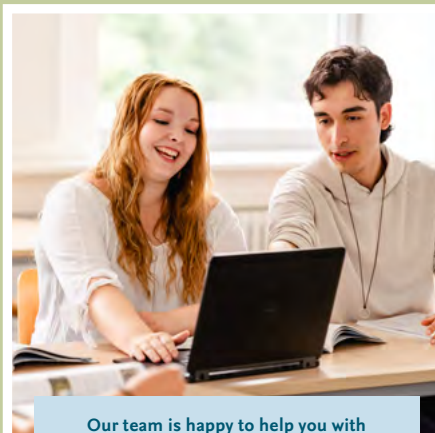

You may be able to transfer these credits to your degree programme, so we recommend consulting your home university's program coordinators in advance to confirm.



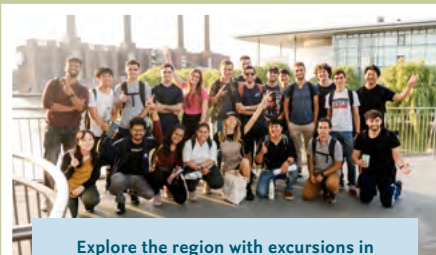
Improve your German language skills and study together with your classmates in our interactive language courses.
